Women's Resource Center of the New River Valley Helps 47 Families with Gifts This Holiday Season.

The annual Women's Resource Center (WRC) Holiday Program, has recently assisted 47 families with holiday donations and gifts with help from businesses and other community members. Over 2,000 donations and gifts were received within the span of two weeks, and 217 children and adults were served.

Gifts arrived in all sizes, shapes, and in an assortment of gift-wrapped colors. Socks, slippers, children's books, games, toys, and kitchenware are only some, among the many, of the donations that were received. No matter what the gifts looked like though, they all came prepackaged with the sole purpose of providing Christmas for families in the New River Valley this holiday season.
